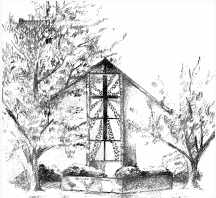

"Following Jesus...Serving Others" Acts 1:8 March 2007

FROM PASTOR STEVE KELLER

Before we can ever step into what God is calling us into, we must first hear His voice or know what he has spoken to us. Recently the Lord has brought two burning passages of Scripture to the body here at St. Giles. They are...

Jeremiah 6:16: This is what the LORD says: "Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls."

Exodus 23:20-26 20: "See, I am sending an angel ahead of you to guard you along the way and to bring you to the place I have prepared. Pay attention to him and listen to what he says. Do not rebel against him; he will not forgive your rebellion, since my Name is in him. If you listen carefully to what he says and do all that I say, I will be an enemy to your enemies and will oppose those who oppose you. My angel will go ahead of you and bring you into the land of the Amorites, Hittites, Perizzites, Canaanites, Hivites and Jebusites, and I will wipe them out. Do not bow down before their gods or worship them or follow their practices. You must demolish them and break their sacred stones to pieces. Worship the LORD your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you, and none will miscarry or be barren in your land. I will give you a full life span."

I'd simply like you to meditate and pray on both of these passages and continue to let the Lord speak to us.
